

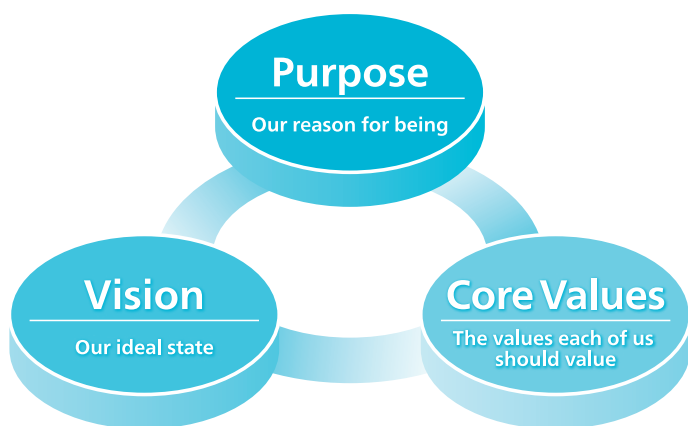

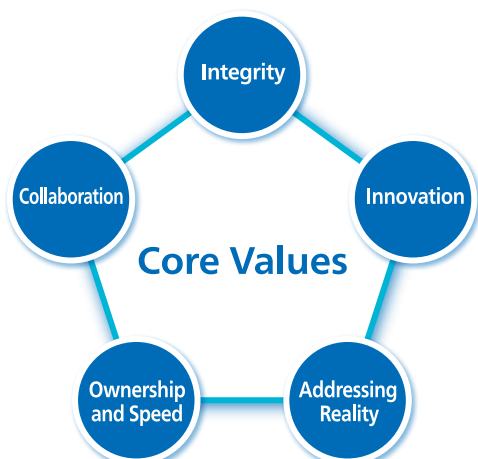

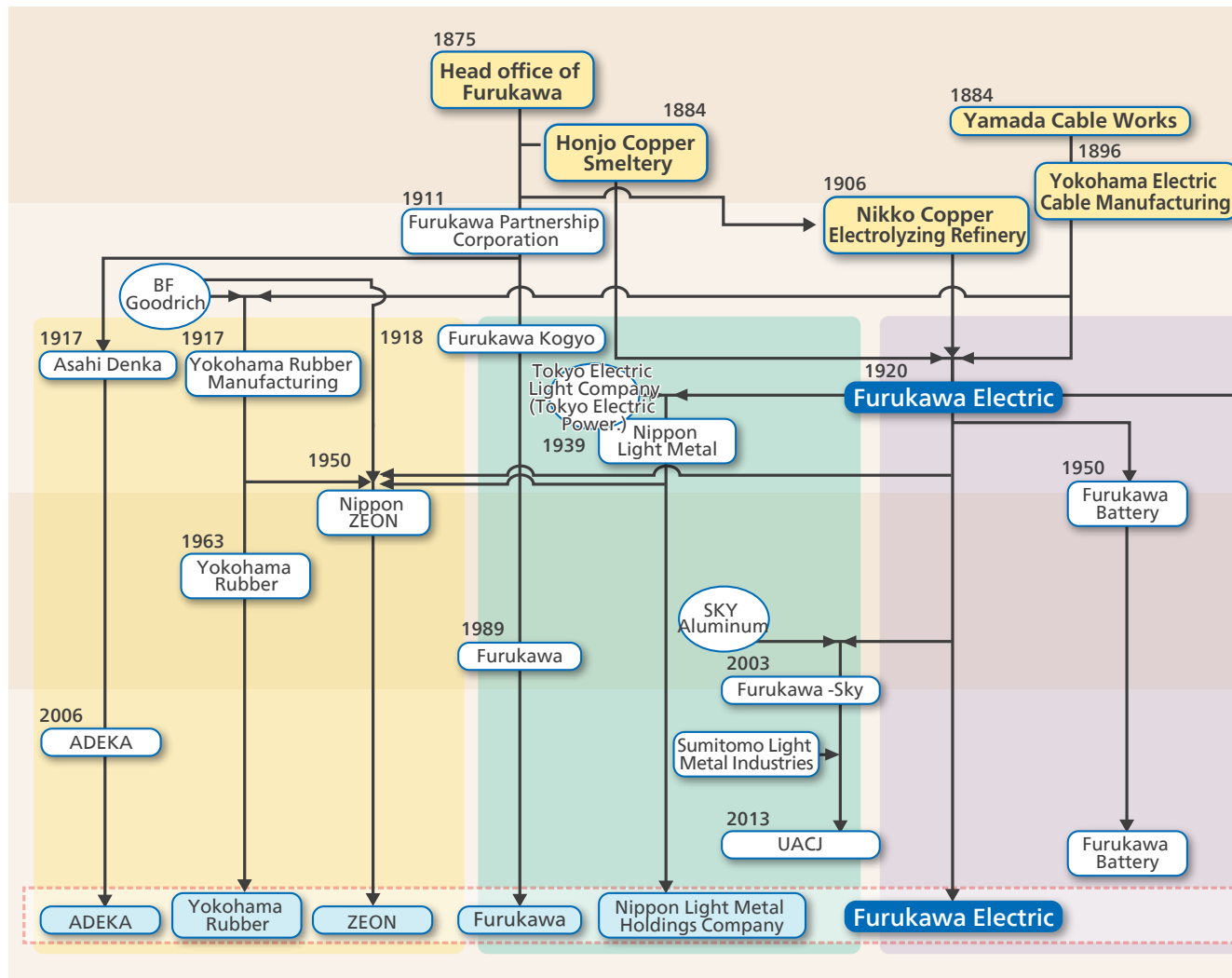

World's first successful field trial of optical fiber cable



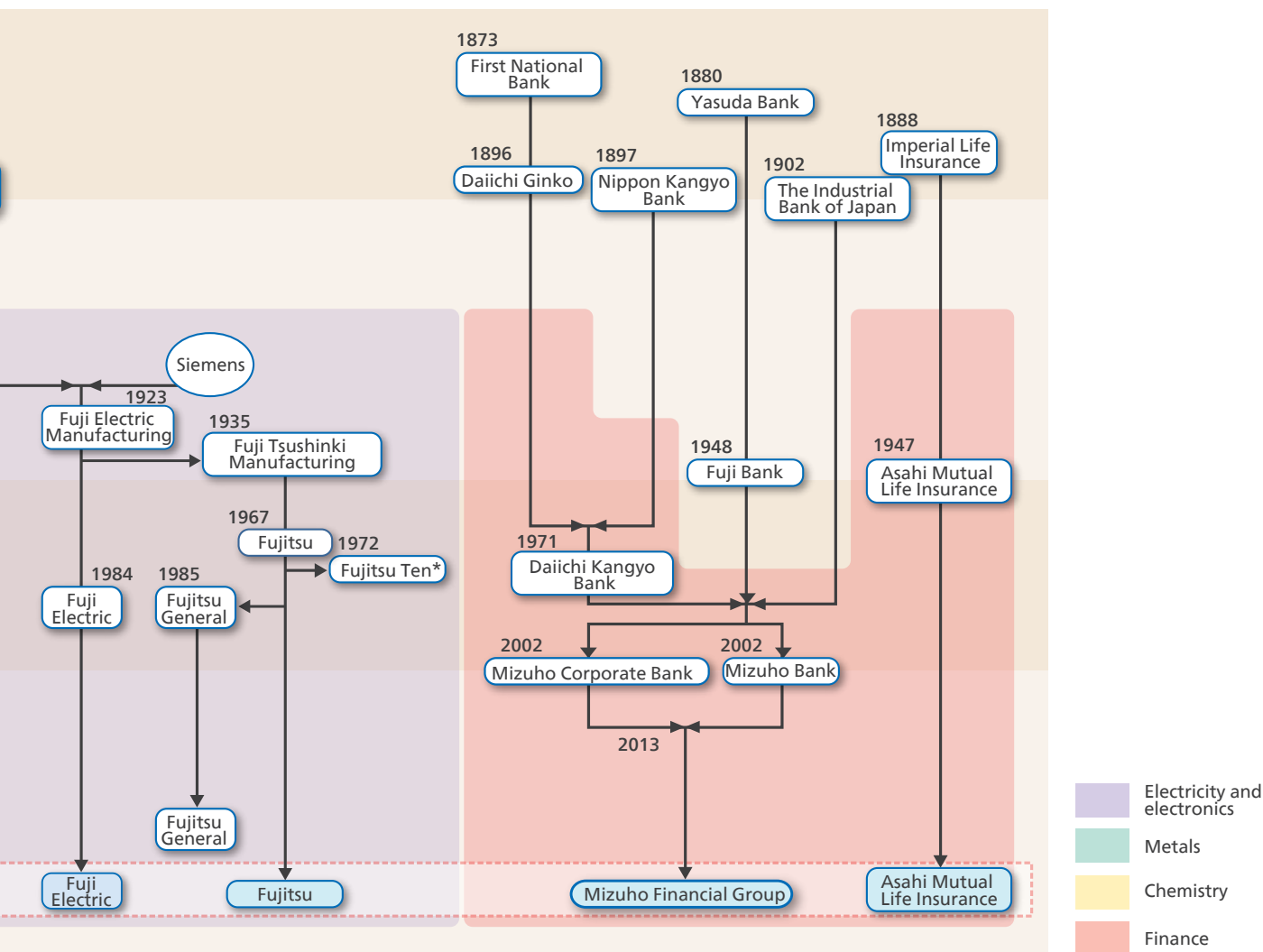
